This brokerage event will focus on connecting experts across disciplines and helping applicants prepare strong Horizon Europe proposals that integrate both SSH (Social Sciences and Humanities) and STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Mathematics) expertise.

The brokerage event brings together researchers, innovators, and stakeholders working on AI-related topics across Horizon Europe, with a strong emphasis on interdisciplinary collaboration.

It is designed for anyone preparing proposals that require AI expertise and meaningful SSH involvement—across fields such as health, digital technologies, climate, environment, and more.

The event will particularly focus on [18 call topics identified in Pillar 2](#) of Horizon Europe where AI has a pivotal role in the call topic text and where there is a clear mention of the involvement of SSH activities.

During the event participants will be able to:

- learn more about the call topics in order to prepare a high-quality proposal;
- get more information about the effective collaboration between SSH and STEM;
- pitch your proposal idea or collaboration offer;
- get in touch with other participants and start building interdisciplinary collaborations.
